Electrical Safety Act 2002

Section 43 of the *Electrical Safety Regulation 2002* prescribes the insurance requirements for an Electrical Contractor Licence. A contract of insurance approved by the chief executive is as follows:

Broad form Public & Products Liability

Limit of Indemnity: at least \$5,000,000 (five million dollars)

Note: Products liability is limited to an aggregate amount of at least \$5,000,000 (five million dollars) for all claims in any one policy period.

Policy limit applies to the following inclusions unless otherwise detailed in the policy schedule:

- Liability arising from testing and certification of work in accordance with the *Electrical Safety Regulation 2002*.
- Injury or damage arising from faulty design work performed by you where you did not charge a specific fee for such design work.
- Injury or damage arising from incorrect advice where you did not charge a specific fee for such advice. The policy must include cover for goods in your care, custody or control.

The policy includes Consumer Protection Liability at least \$50,000 (fifty thousand dollars)
