



INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Electrical Contractor's Licence (Business)

What is the insurance requirement for an electrical contractor?

Section 43 of the *Electrical Safety Regulation 2002* requires that electrical contractors have public liability insurance for at least \$5,000,000 under a contract of insurance approved by the chief executive.

How do I meet this requirement?

To satisfy this requirement, you need to obtain a **certificate of currency** from your insurer that confirms you have a policy with **broadform public and products liability** with a limit of indemnity of **\$5,000,000** (minimum).

This policy **must** include cover for testing and certification of work and liability for goods in your care, custody or control arising from:

- resultant injury, loss or damage arising from a faulty design where you design and install; and
- resultant injury, loss or damage arising from incorrect advice where you give advice.

This policy **must** include cover for consumer protection liability for **\$50,000**
