3. I am not the subject of disciplinary proceedings in New Zealand (including any preliminary investigations or action that might lead to disciplinary proceedings) in relation to this occupation.
4. My registration in New Zealand is not cancelled or currently suspended as a result of disciplinary action.
5. I am not otherwise personally prohibited from carrying on any such occupation in New Zealand, and am not subject to any special conditions in carrying on that occupation, as a result of criminal, civil or disciplinary proceedings in New Zealand.
6. I am subject to the following special conditions in the carrying out of my occupation in New Zealand:

7. I give consent to the Department of Industrial Relations to make inquiries of, and exchange information with, the authorities of New Zealand regarding my activities in the occupation or otherwise regarding matters relevant to this declaration.
